The EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) replaces the Data Protection Directive 95/46/EC and provides a consistency in data privacy laws across Europe.

The primary objectives of the GDPR are to give control back to citizens and residents over their personal data and to simplify the regulatory environment for international business by unifying the regulation within the EU.

These regulations are being introduced in the UK before Brexit and the UK Government has confirmed its commitment to the GDPR.

There is a potential fine up to 20,000,000 EUR or up to 4% of the annual worldwide turnover of an enterprise, whichever is greater, for failure to comply with the directive.

Identify Vulnerabilities in your Network and Systems.

An organisation that conducts regular penetration tests stands a much larger chance of blocking cyber-attacks due to their knowledge of their vulnerabilities.

The initial goal of the penetration test is to breach the outer network perimeter. Once breached access is then leveraged to expose any vulnerabilities in the core network and associated devices.
